The inscription on back of his tombstone is from a hymn by Isaac Watts titled A Happy Resurrection; it reads:

No, I'll repine at Death no more,
But with a cheerful Gasp resign
To the cold Dungeon of the Grave
These dying, withering limbs of mine.

Let Worms devour my wasting Flesh,
And crumble all my Bones to Dust,
My God shall raise my frame anew
At the Revival of the Just.
