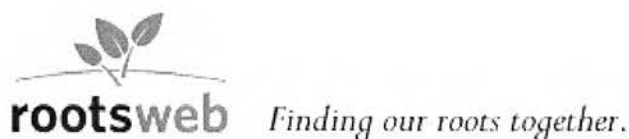
Thomas Wallace (Wallis), born about 1795 in North Carolina, apparently moved to South Carolina as a youth, then about 1818-1820, moved to Lauderdale County, Alabama. Thomas died in Lauderdale County in 1874. I am searching for descendants of some of his heirs:

1. Thomas Shelby Wallace who apparently died shortly before his father. The estate settlement of Thomas Wallace indicated that at least three children of Thomas Shelby Wallace were residing in Holmes County, Mississippi at that time. The children were identified as:

John T. Wallace, age 6
Melanie (?) B. Wallace, age 4, and
William T. Wallace, age 18 mo.

2. Samuel Wallace, residing in Fulton County, Arkansas.

* 3. Harrison Kendrick Wallace, residing in Grayson County, Texas. I do have some information relating to Harrison. His wife was Elizabeth E. and 2-3 of their children are buried in Hall Cemetery near Howe, Grayson County, Texas, but I do not have any information regarding his descendants.

Hello,

My name is Ralph Wallace of Florence, Lauderdale County, Alabama. I am descended from Thomas Wallace who came to Lauderdale County about 1820 from South Carolina. Thomas was born about 1795 in North Carolina and died in Lauderdale Co., AL, November 11, 1874. The estate settlement for Thomas Wallace (spelled Wallace or Wallis in various documents) listed 9 children:

1. James L. Wallis, b. about 1813 and living in Lauderdale Co., AL in 1876.
2. Alexander McWallis (McCuin/McEwen Wallis), b. about 1815 and residing in Lauderdale Co. in 1876. Mac was my g-g-grandfather.
3. John Burros Wallis, b. about 1825 and died in Lauderdale Co. in 1876. At that time his children were identified as James

Wallis, Nancy

Wade, wife of Samuel Wade and Burros Wallis, all residing in Gibson

County, Denton Station, Tennessee and all over age 21 and Sallie Wallis

age 23 years, Samuel Wallis age over 21 years, Eddy Wallis age 16 years,

Jesse Wallis age 14 years, Daniel Wallis age 11 years and Ella Wallis

age 8 years, all residing in Lauderdale Co., AL.

4. The children of Mary S. Montgomery, daughter of Thomas Wallis,

listed as Lafayette Montgomery, George W. Montgomery, Mary Smith wife of

Robert Smith, and Hettie F. Wallis Darby wife of (John) D. Darby, all

over age and residing in Wayne County, TN.

5. Hattie (Hettie) F. Davis wife of William Carroll Davis who resides

in Grayson County, TX

6. Thomas Shelby Wallis, reported recently deceased, leaving children

John T. Wallis age 6 years, Melanie (?) B. Wallis age 4 years and

William T. Wallis age 18 months, all minors and reside in Holmes County, MS.

7. Selenas Wallis, deceased, leaving children Sarah Wallis age 21

years, Hattie Wallis age 17 years and Selenas Wallis age 14 years and

all reside in Lauderdale Co.

* 8. (Harrison) Kendrick Wallis, b. about 1830 and residing in Grayson

County, TX in 1876.

9. Samuel Wallis, b. about 1833 and residing in Fulton County, Arkansas

in 1876.

I am descended from Alexander McQuin (McEwen?) Wallis (Wallace) and have

information on the descendants of James Wallis, John Burros Wallis and

Hettie Wallis Davis, but I do not have information on the descendants of

Mary Wallis Montgomery, Thomas Shelby Wallis, Selenas Wallis, Harrison

Kendrick Wallis or Samuel Wallis.

✎ I do know that Harrison K. Wallace is listed in the 1860

census in
Grayson County, Texas, with his wife Elizabeth E. and
children Frances
D., b. c1848 in TN, Mahaly J., b. c1852 in TN, Mary F., b.
c1856 in MO
and Thomas W., b. c1858/1860 in Texas. Harrison doesn't show
up in the
1870 census but is back in the 1880 census which lists H. K.
Wallace age
48, b. in AL and his wife E. E. age 48, b. in AL with
children Samuel
age 14, b. TX, J. A. (son) age 8, b. TX, A. S. (daughter)
age 8, b. TX,
L. M. (daughter) age 18, b. TX and D. C. (n)(possible
nephew) age 14, b.
AL. The children shown in the 1860 census are not listed,
but they
would have been of age and probably on their own. However,
they are not
listed elsewhere in the 1880 census. It appears that
Harrison may have
left Grayson County (and possibly Texas) after 1860 and
returned by
1873. It is possible that he was there in 1870, but living
in another
household, but I have not pursued this avenue. Neither he
nor any of
his children appear in the 1900 census for Grayson County,
Texas. Hall
Cemetery at Howe, Grayson County, Texas, has graves for
three of his
children: John A. Wallace, son of H. K. and E. E., June 1,
1880 to
November 29 1881, Lucinda M., daughter of H. K. and E. E.
Wallace, died
June 30, 1881 at age 22, and Infant babe of H. K. and E. E.
Wallace, b.
and d. September 5, 1873.

I have also been unable to verify the father of Thomas
Wallace. There
is an indication that he could be the son of John Wallace
who died in
York County, SC in 1816. Thomas was appointed one of the
administrators
of the estate and in 1826 he was appointed guardian of two
minor
children of John Wallace, but none of the 50 pages of
material in John's
estate settlement specify the relationship between John and

Thomas.

I am interested in any information regarding any of the descendants of Thomas Wallace and information on his parents. I would appreciate any information that anyone can supply on this family.
