"Chileab Smith, the third son of Lieut. Samuel and Elisabeth Smith was born in Wethersfield, Conn. about 1635 and died March 7, 1731 at age of 95; m. Oct. 2, 1661, Hannah Hitchcock, b. in Wethersfield about 1645; d. in Hadley, Mass., Aug. 31, 1733. She was a daughter of Luke and Elizabeth (Gibbons) Hitchcock who, according to "Savage" arrived in Wethersfield from New Haven Conn. about 1644. Luke Hitchcock was born in England and died in Wethersfield Nov. 1, 1659. He was a Townsman (Selectman) in 1653 and 1656 and was one of the 59 who met at Goodman Ward's house April 18, 1659 in Hartford and agreed to move to the new plantation in Massachusetts, that later became Hadley. He seems never to have moved to Hadley, however. He married Elizabeth Gibbons a sister of the prominent and wealthy
