Carllene Veal wrote, "There are no references to Carnaby Veal, Prince William Co, VA other than the Will of his father. He is next found in Amherst County, VA in 1762" (p. 10). No will has been found for Carnaby. His land was surveyed for him by M. Cabel, Jr., Surveyor, on 16 Mar 1762, and it is now part of the Blue Ridge National Park. Carllene Veal characterizes this family as "mountain men whose land was on the branches of the south fork of Buffalo River and on the long Mountain" (p. 11). Keith Moody noted that Carnaby disappeared from the tax rolls of Amherst Co. VA about 1794. There is no known proof of Carnaby's wife's name.
