Notes	Evidently John's son Richard was here first (before John, M.D.). I found traces of him in Hemp stead L.I. and one reference on a deed of sale to his being from "County of Yorkshire, North Riding". See the Annals of Hempstead - 1643 - 1832 by Henry Onderdonk, Jr., Page 232 (From Frances R. Stites (10)\. In these same annals, which is copied from original records officially filed with the town clierk—there are numerous references to Richard—suits for damages, purchase and sale of property (land and cows) and his will which was probated i 1709 (which conflicts with reported daite of death i 1702). It was one of these deeds dated March 11, 1680 when he sold land to Henry Willis that states: I, Richard Stites of Westberry in y'e bound s of Hempstead on Long Isl and nd County of Yorkshier in y'd north Riding thereof, which would indicate that he came from that section of England, although your records show him to have been born in London.
